LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR THE RENEWAL OF CONTRACT TO MANAGE AND USE THE ART PAVILION "CVIJETA ZUZORIC" BY THE ASSOCIATION OF FINE ARTISTS SERBIA (ULUS)

To whom it may concern,

We, the International Association of Art Europe (IAA Europe), hereby declare our utmost support to the Association of Fine Artists of Serbia (ULUS) in its struggle to maintain its long term rights of usage of Art Pavilion Cvijeta Zuzorić as its headquarters and main exhibition space.

The International Association of Art (IAA) Europe is a network of 40 national member organisations within Europe, representing professional visual artists. It is one of the five cultural regions of the International Association of Art (IAA/AIAP), the largest international non-governmental association of visual artists, working in official partnership with UNESCO. Main objectives of IAA Europe are the exchange between artists and organisations engaged in the fields of art and culture in Europe and beyond, the discussion and elaboration of artistic matters within Europe as well as the promotion of the flow of information regarding e.g. working conditions, social security systems, authors' rights and free flow of artworks. It aims to make artists' interests known to European political institutions and their representatives.

In respect of the inherent connection between ULUS and the Pavilion since its construction, we encourage the relevant authorities to resolve the pending dispute and honor ULUS with an indefinite rights of usage contract with no compensation that will protect both the organization and the building as well as benefit the development of high quality arts and culture in Serbia.
